### **Minutes/Regular Called Meeting of August 6, 2020**

Steven Gregory, City Attorney, read an Ordinance Enacting and Adopting a Supplement to the Code of Ordinance of the City of Shelbyville, Kentucky.

**Ordinance No. 2020-09-03(A)/An Ordinance Levying Ad Valorem Property Taxes for the Calendar Year 2020 – 1<sup>st</sup> Reading, Steven Gregory**

Steven Gregory, City Attorney, read an Ordinance Levying Ad Valorem Property Taxes for the Calendar Year 2020.

The Ad Valorem Property Taxes for the calendar year 2020 will be twenty-seven point zero cents (27.0) per \$100 dollars of assessed value of taxable real property and thirty-three point five cents (33.5) on each \$100 dollars of assessed value of personal property within the City limits of Shelbyville.

Councilmember Swindler moved to approve the Ordinance for a second reading. Seconded by Councilmember Ethington.

**Budget Ordinance/An Ordinance Adopting the City of Shelbyville, Kentucky Budget Amendment for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, 2nd Reading, Mayor David B. Eaton**

Mayor David B. Eaton explained and read the amended revenue to the City of Shelbyville, Kentucky Budget Amendment.

Councilmember Suttor moved to approve the Ordinance. Seconded by Councilmember Page.
