Minutes Regular July 7, 2016

Ordinance No. 2016-07-21 – An Ordinance Annexing Property to the City of Shelbyville – 2nd Reading – Steven Gregory

Steven Gregory, City Attorney, read an ordinance of the City of Shelbyville annexing property owned by Micromont Holding 3, LLC that is contiguous to the City of Shelbyville and is suitable for urban purposes, without unreasonable delay. The property is not included within the bounds of any other incorporated city, and the owners have executed a written consent to be annexed within the city limits of Shelbyville.

This is the existing Zaxby’s property. The owners are requesting to be annexed into the city.

It was introduced for second reading by Councilmember Swindler. Seconded by Councilmember Andriot.

Ordinance – An Ordinance of the City of Shelbyville Creating the position of Historic District Assistant - 1st Reading – Steven Gregory

Steven Gregory, City Attorney, read an ordinance of the City of Shelbyville creating the position of Historic District Assistant, under general supervision, performs a variety of administrative support work in conjunction with the Historic District Coordinator; and acts as a liaison to the to the Shelby County Historical Society (SCHS).
