### About Shelbyville Curbside Recycling

- Curbside recycling is an every-other week service.
- Please put your recycle container at the curb for pickup on the evening before your service day.
- Only approved recycle materials will be serviced in the recycle containers; we will not dump a recycle container as trash.
- Please note the list of materials that can and cannot be recycled with this service.
- Recycling is co-mingled and does not need to be sorted or bagged; place all items together loose in your container.

### Holiday Schedule

- During holiday weeks, we will be adjusting our service schedule by one day for the remainder of those weeks.

### Examples of Recyclable Materials

- Paper Products: cardboard, magazines, newspaper, phone books, junk mail, office paper, dry goods boxes (cereal, pasta, cake, etc).
- Metal: aluminum (soda or beer cans), steel food cans\* and aerosol cans (must be empty).
- Plastic: any #1 or #2 plastic bottles or jugs (soda bottles, milk jugs\*, detergent bottles, etc).
- **PLEASE NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
- Glass: any color bottles (soda, beer) and jars (baby food, pickles, pasta sauce, etc).\*

\*Note: All food containers should be rinsed; labels are okay.

### Non-Recyclable Materials

- Yard waste (grass clippings, limbs, leaves, etc).
- Scrap metal or coat hangars.
- Styrofoam of any kind.
- Plastic grocery bags (return to store for recycling).
- Drink and refrigerated packaging (soda box, frozen food).
