PART TIME FIREFIGHTER I

The Shelbyville Fire Department is accepting applications for **part time firefighters.**

General Duties: This position serves under the Fire Captain or Fire Sergeant and routinely works a scheduled 24 hours per week in 12 and 24-hour shifts. Responsibilities for this position include, but are not limited to: serving as a professional Firefighter/EMT on and off the fire ground; executing station duties; inspecting facilities to ensure clean, orderly and safe work environments; ensuring that apparatus and equipment are clean and maintained in proper working order; answering calls for emergency and non-emergency services normally associated with those of a Firefighter/EMT.

Required Qualifications:

- Must be at least eighteen years of age by date of application
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- A valid driver's license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky
- Successful completion of an internal Fire Candidate Physical Agility Course and an internal written exam with a passing score of 75%. The exam will be comprised of material from the latest version of the IFSTA Essentials of Firefighting, Firefighter I curriculum. **If an agility test has been completed within the last six (6) months, no agility test will be required.**

Desired Qualifications:

- 150-hour certification
 - 400-hour certification and the IFSAC Firefighter I and II established and certified by the Kentucky Fire Commission are preferred, but not required.
- Emergency Medical Technician Certification (EMT-B or EMT-A or P) as established and certified by the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services (KBEMS)
- Certificates from the US Department of Homeland Security/FEMA that include NIMS IS-100, 200, 700 and 800.
- OSHA 1910: 120/NFPA 472 Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations Level Certification

Salary: \$12.82/hour. Compensated for call-back events and training events. Part time firefighters who are already enrolled in the CERS pension system will also get pension credit for time worked in this position.
